REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORDS

Ref: (a) Title 10 U.S.C. 1552

1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show entitled to full separation allowance when discharged on 30 December 1998.

2. The Board, consisting of Messrs. Dunn, Flood, and Swarens, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 October 1999 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. When Petitioner was discharged on 30 December 1998 he was authorized payment of "full separation" allowance and assigned a separation code of "LBK" vice "JGH".


(NOTE: For DFAS: Petitioner departed on terminal leave on 27 November 1998 and states that he has never received payment for the period of time for 27 November 1998 through 30 December 1998. Please verify from pay record and if Petitioner has not been paid, he should be paid. Petitioner is also entitled to travel pay for himself and his dependents to a location not to exceed travel to his place of enlistment or his home of record.

For Petitioner: Petitioner should go to the closest facility which can compute travel vouchers and ask them to compute monies due for the travel pay. Petitioner must present to the Agency computing the travel pay due a copy of any previous vouchers pertaining to the travel pay associated with his discharge from active duty for himself and his dependents. **The Agency making the computation will not make the actual payment.** Petitioner will then forward the computation of monies due, a copy of this letter and all other vouchers pertaining to the travel pay to DFAS-DE/FYCC, 6760 E Irving Place, Denver, CO 80279-7100.)

b. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
